1	<p>Update Your Operating System:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">For Windows: Go to Settings > Update & Security > Windows Update, and click "Check for updates."For Mac: Go to System Preferences > Software Update, and follow the prompts.	
2	<p>Update Drivers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Use Windows Update for Windows or System Update for Mac to ensure all drivers are up to date.For specific hardware drivers (e.g., graphics card), visit the manufacturer's website for the latest updates.	
3	<p>Run Antivirus Scans:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Ensure your antivirus software is up to date and perform regular scans to detect and remove malware.	
4	<p>Clear Temporary Files:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">For Windows: Use Disk Cleanup (search for "Disk Cleanup" in the Start menu).For Mac: Use the built-in storage management tool (Apple menu > About This Mac > Storage > Manage).	
5	<p>Backup Important Data:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Use external drives, cloud services, or backup software to regularly back up your important files and data.	
6	<p>Check for Hardware Issues:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Inspect your computer and peripherals for any physical damage or wear. Clean your keyboard, screen, and vents	

How To Guide

Updating Your Operating System:

- Windows: Click the Start menu > Settings > Update & Security > Windows Update, then click "Check for updates." Install any available updates.
- Mac: Click the Apple menu > System Preferences > Software Update. Follow the on-screen instructions to install updates.

Updating Drivers:

- Windows: Use Windows Update as described above, or visit the hardware manufacturer's website to download and install the latest drivers.
- Mac: Drivers are typically included in system updates, so keep your macOS up to date.

Running Antivirus Scans:

- Open your antivirus software (e.g., Windows Defender, Norton, McAfee).
- Ensure the software is up to date.
- Run a full system scan and follow any prompts to remove detected threats.

Clearing Temporary Files:

- Windows: Search for "Disk Cleanup" in the Start menu. Select the drive you want to clean and follow the prompts to remove temporary files.
- Mac: Click the Apple menu > About This Mac > Storage > Manage, and use the tools provided to clean up storage.

Backing Up Important Data:

- Connect an external drive or set up a cloud backup service.
- Follow the software's instructions to back up your files regularly.

Updating Software and Applications:

- Open each application and look for an option to check for updates (usually in the Help or Settings menu).
- Install any available updates.

Checking for Hardware Issues:

- Physically inspect your computer and peripherals for any damage.
- Clean your keyboard with compressed air and a soft cloth.
- Wipe your screen with a microfiber cloth.
